New Organizations:

- PLIS: Policy holders and insurance claims; general knowledge when people file claims; come out more informed when you make a property
  - Approved unanimously
- EASL and FAD: combine them into one organization since they overlap; not active since they didn't hold elections
  - Approved unanimously

Organization updates:

- Summit was successful; only four organizations weren't present (signing up for rooms)
- Encouraged for people to sign up

Budget

- Annual budget: \$66,781
  - Subtracted from Stonewall's conference budget
  - Only 6 organizations did not turn in their budget
  - Organizations requesting a total of 44,000
    - Should we do a 25% increase for the organizations that used their funds/for organizations that didn't use that much money or didn't use money at all have a standard limit of 381? Or should we approve event by event?
      - The only issue is the travel aspect. The rest of funding request we will approve event by event.
  - The breakdown:
    - Soft Approval → These are the goals for the budget; tentative
- Budget Requests
  - Everyone is guaranteed \$200 for their welcome back meeting
  - A lot of orgs are requesting money for conferences/travel
    - Federal Trade Commission \$300
      - Six student orgs are co-sponsoring (FBA, FED Soc, IPSA, PIN, BLS, HLSA)
      - Federal trade commission holding an event to find interns, and then holding a reception at Akerman
      - The funding is for food for event
      - Approved
