Content Description:

First Panel: Ibero-American Legal Education for the Third Decade of the 21st Century: Challenges and Advances: How should we train the new generations of legal professionals to face the challenges of the 21st century? Many jurists emphasize preparing students for a world with artificial intelligence, where much of the information will be available for free and instantaneously. At the same time, beyond technological development, the constitutional rule of law in Ibero-America constantly faces challenges. In response to this reality, law schools and faculties have embarked on curricular reforms to prepare new generations of professionals. This panel will share experiences on these reforms and different approaches to legal education.

Second Panel: The Legal Professions in Ibero-America in the Third Decade of the 21st Century: Challenges and Advances: There is no doubt that the legal profession is undergoing significant change, especially considering the opportunities and challenges presented by artificial intelligence. Additionally, the role of law in societies is discussed often, particularly its central role in social and economic development. This panel will feature presentations from various law schools and faculties in the region, sharing their visions on the legal profession and legal education in this challenging context.

Third Panel: The Supreme Courts of Justice in Ibero-America in the Third Decade of the 21st Century: Challenges and Advances: This discussion will consist of a conversation on the jurisprudential trends of the high courts in Ibero-America, focusing on their most recent cases with legal and political impact and public opinion. Although the speakers will concentrate on the superior courts of their respective countries, the objective of the panel is to provide a space for reflection, sharing experiences, and discussing visions on the role and importance of jurisprudence and the rule of law in the region.

SIPE Panel: The Intersection of Law and New Technologies: A Transatlantic Vision: This roundtable discussion will feature an academic exchange between law professors from Europe and the Americas on the interaction between law and the new technologies that have emerged in the context of Web 3.0. Participants will offer their perspectives on the symbiotic relationship between law and technological innovations of this century, with special emphasis on the impact these have had on institutions, legal professionals (judges, lawyers, prosecutors, law students, and academic jurists), the regulation of human activities, and the legal system in general.
