## CERTIFICATION OF EMPLOYMENT

The FIU College of Law Academic Policies and Regulations # 601 provide that:

*A full-time first year student should not undertake any employment, because the rigorous demands of law study require the full energy and time of the student. No full-time law student may be employed for more than an average of 20 hours per week in which the student is enrolled in more than 12 class hours. This restriction may be waived prospectively by the Dean or the Dean's designee upon written request for good cause shown.*

If I do need to work more than 20 hours per week, I understand that I must establish good cause and obtain a waiver from the Dean or the Dean's designee.
